^A The Parent Coordinator Level Code is the Coordinator Level Code of the Coordinator level "above" the current Coordinator level in the Coordinator's hierarchy. For example, if the "California" region with a code of "CA" is grouped under the "West" region with a code of "W", then the Parent Coordinator Level Code for Coordinator Level "CA" would be "W". If the Coordinator Level is the "root" level within the Coordinator, then this value should be empty. *The file must include the Coordinator levels in an appropriate order, i.e., a parent Coordinator level must appear in the file before any Coordinator level that uses it as a parent Coordinator level.*

^B Coordinator Level Total Respondent Goal Type valid values:
1 – Count
2 – Percentage

Other Notes

- The comma delimited export (csv) uses the double quote (") as the text qualifier and the comma character as a field delimiter.
- The tab delimited export (txt) uses the tab character as a field delimiter.
- Field names may be included as the first row of the file, the first row of the file is optional.
